The here in question is a happening London rave club in the early 90s, and the human life includes a recently dumped bloke and his best mate, the ex-girlfriend and her chum, a couple of posh, clueless teens trying to act cool, stropky cloakroom attendant, two bimbos snorting coke and talking rubbish in the toilets, a mixed up bouncer, some guy who's off his face, drag queens, and the promoter whose seeing his mate's wife on the side.

Cutting between the different characters over the course of the night, it feels more like a sketch show than a film, but at least it's mostly very funny and, mixed live by DJs Brandon Block, Mr C and Alex P, the music certainly gives it an authentic feel for the time and place.
