Club Le Monde is Simon (The Truth Game) Rumley's latest dissection of urban life but, like AKA, it unwisely chooses an era seemingly custom-made to cause an inexperienced director problems.

This time, we're in the early 1990s and ready to rave at Frank Harper's eponymous nightclub, where drugs are easily available and the music pumps until dawn. Rumley is a good writer – some of the dialogue is roarily funny, while some cleverly illustrates the ridiculous posturing that gets British males into so much trouble – but he's an amateurish director, and the club scene has been filmed too many times by now to benefit from his awkward contribution.
